G1.2 Environmental Management System

Environmental risk and impact assessment is carried out on a regular basis on issues listed below:

- Waste management
- Environmental, health and safety criteria for cleaning products, chemicals and/or hazardous substances
- Sourcing standards and practices for food and beverages
- Energy consumption and efficiency
- Water management (conservation, withdrawal, and wastewater)
- Pollution (air, water)
- Emissions
- Biodiversity
- Transport
- Renewable Energy
- Indoor air and light quality
- Hygienic and pest-free environment
- Laundry and cleaning
- Hotel design
- Sustainable food preparation
- Food waste

So since 2012 we have implemented a system that details monthly records on energy, electricity, water, gas, co2, waste to landfill and recycling. All measures are recorded electronically to our Green Engage software, allowing to immediately:

- identify any potential issues arising in consumption of the above (e.g. leaks, failures etc)
- measure positive impact of equipment (e.g., Waste compactor, compost machine)
- evaluate effectiveness of employee training in conducted and consequent habit change

The findings of risks and opportunities are discussed at monthly green engage meetings, resulting in identifying areas of potential savings. We further engage our people across the hotel and also involve external suppliers, sharing risk assessment procedure (APP 60/a/b)
